Kinghorn Shop Assistant Rings Up a Lotto Win

Lady Luck clearly shops at the Kinghorn Co-op, as a shop assistant there has won a whole 'Lotto' cash with a lucky ticket she bought in the store.

Sandra Sinclair (43) has been buying her Lotto tickets at the Kinghorn Co-op where she works since the lottery started. She has now 'checked-out' an amazing £56,911 Lotto win, after matching five numbers and the bonus ball in the draw held on Saturday 26 November 2005

Sandra commented: "It's very handy – I don't have to go too far to get my ticket. I was at home with my son Gareth, watching the draw on TV when I saw the balls come out. Even though I knew they were my numbers straight away, I still had to check them – I was stunned but very excited."

Now the cash is starting to 'register', Sandra is planning a shopping spree on the other side of the counter. While she has no plans to give up work but she is going to invest in some major DIY with her winnings.

The winning ticket was bought from the Co-op store on Kinghorn High Street. The winning Lotto numbers on Saturday 26 November were 19, 27, 28, 34, 39, 46 and the bonus number: 07.

This Wednesday (30 November) there is an estimated £2.8 million Lotto jackpot and an estimated £3.7 million Lotto Extra jackpot available to win – while this Friday's (2 December) EuroMillions Rollover jackpot is an estimated £22 million.
