They both enjoyed a big win on Wednesday, with Lucas scoring in the 1-0 victory over AS Nancy in UEFA Cup and Trevor pocketing a cool £907,811. When it comes to the goals he has lined up for spending his new-found Lotto fortune, Trevor's first priority is a 'home win' – as he plans to find a new house in his native Great Harwood. He is also looking forward to looking after his wife, Elaine (40), and their three sons, Paul (28), Liam (21) and Scott (16).

Trevor is an engineer at local company, Wirex, and was checking his numbers in the paper when he realised that Christmas had kicked off early for him. At first he thought he had won a tenner but after his workmate double-checked, he ran to the local Co-Op where his wife works to tell her the good news.

Trevor said: "I was paying extra attention when I checked my ticket – I'd forgotten to take my usual numbers with me when I bought my ticket, so I chose a Luck Dip instead. It's all gone a bit mad and everyone seems to have found out. My son Scott found out about the win before I had told him. He thought it was all a wind-up and I got a text asking me if it was all true. We were planning a family Christmas with friends and we don't want to change that – our family and friends are what's most important."

Trevor's lucky Lotto Lucky Dip<sup>®</sup> ticket was bought at Morrison's Blackburn. The winning Lotto numbers on 13 December were: 4, 12, 14, 20, 46 and 49.
