Rachel (34) a trainee solicitor explained: "On Monday my horoscope said 'luck would visit door 12', which is my house number and then on Wednesday the stars advised me 'The Moon lights your prize chart so keep your lottery ticket in a safe place'. Fortunately I took the hint and rushed out to my local Co-Op in Leabrooks and bought a Lotto Lucky Dip ticket."

It was not until Thursday morning when Rachel checked via the Internet, that she discovered the predictions had come true. "I just couldn't believe it at first", said Rachel, "I had to check the ticket again and even then I thought I must be dreaming."

Rachel's husband Tony (39), who works for Griffiths Laboratories in Sommercotes, received an urgent message to go home, but knew nothing about the win until he walked through the front door. Tony said: "I walked in and Rachel told me the fantastic news, she had tears of joy in her eyes".

The win comes at an exciting time for Rachel, as not only will she be celebrating her birthday on the 21st January, but she qualifies as a fully fledged solicitor at the beginning of February.
