## £93K Up For Grabs In Birmingham

An amazing EuroMillions prize of £93,764 has yet to be claimed in the Birmingham area, and National Lottery players are being urged to check and double-check their tickets for their chance to claim this life-changing prize.

The search is now on to locate the owner of the winning ticket who matched five numbers in the EuroMillions draw on Friday 3 November 2006. The winning EuroMillions numbers on that date were 11, 13, 24, 44, and 49. The lucky ticket-holder has until 5.30pm on 2 May 2007 to come forward and make their claim.

If no-one comes forward with the winning ticket before the prize claim deadline, then the prize money, plus all the interest it has generated, will go to the Good Causes – adding to the £19 billion already raised through sales of lottery tickets in the 12 years since The National Lottery® launched in November 1994.

A National Lottery spokesperson said: “We’re desperate to find this mystery ticket-holder and unite them with their winnings – this life-changing prize could really help to make a few dreams a reality for someone out there. We’re urging everyone to check their old tickets again or look anywhere a missing EuroMillions ticket could be hiding.

“Try checking in the pockets of clothing, in wallets, bags and down the back of the sofa – someone out there could literally be sitting on a fortune! We have the champagne on ice and our fingers crossed that the lucky winner comes forward to claim their win.”

To jog Lotto players’ memories, on 3 November 2006 *Sixty Six*, starring Helena Bonham-Carter and Catherine Tate, was showing at cinemas across the country – while McFly topped the charts with *Star Girl*.

Numbers can be entered in advance and lucky winners automatically receive a cheque or are notified online if their numbers come up.
