## £1 Million Lotto Prize Up For Grabs In Peterborough

An amazing Lotto jackpot prize of £1,016,840 has yet to be claimed in the Peterborough area, and National Lottery players are being urged to check and double-check their tickets for their chance to claim this life-changing prize.

The search is now on to locate the owner of the jackpot-winning ticket who matched all six numbers in the Lotto draw on Saturday 28 October 2006. The winning Lotto numbers on that date were 4, 5, 6, 12, 20, 29 and the bonus ball was 30. The lucky ticket-holder has until 5.30pm on 26 April 2007 to come forward and make their claim.

If no-one comes forward with the winning ticket before the prize claim deadline expires, then the prize money, plus all the interest it has generated, will go to the Good Causes – adding to the £19 billion already raised through sales of lottery tickets in the 12 years since The National Lottery® launched in November 1994.

A National Lottery spokesperson said: “We’re desperate to find this mystery ticket-holder and unite them with their winnings – this life-changing prize could really help to make dreams become a reality for someone out there. We’re urging everyone to check their old tickets again or look anywhere a missing Lotto ticket could be hiding. Try checking in the pockets of clothing, in wallets, bags and down the back of the sofa – someone out there could literally be sitting on a fortune! We have the champagne on ice and our fingers crossed that the lucky winner comes forward to claim their share of the jackpot in time.”

To jog Lotto players’ memories, on 28 October 2006 *All the King’s Men*, starring Jude Law and Kate Winslet, was showing at cinemas across the country – while My Chemical Romance topped the charts with *Welcome to the Black Parade*. Closer to home, Peterborough United drew 2-2 at home to Grimsby Town, while audiences at the Key Theatre were enjoying a production of Mozart’s *The Marriage of Figaro*.
