Lotto Prize Remains Unclaimed In Islington

An amazing **£98,381** Lotto win has yet to be claimed in the Borough of Islington, so National Lottery players are being urged to check and double-check their tickets for the chance to claim this life-enhancing prize.

The search is now on to find the owner of the winning ticket, who matched five numbers plus the bonus ball in the Lotto draw on Saturday 21 July 2007. The winning numbers on that date were 3, 10, 21, 25, 29, 49, and the bonus ball was 20. The lucky ticket-holder has until 5.30pm on Thursday 17 January 2008 to come forward and make their claim.

If no-one comes forward with the winning ticket before the prize claim deadline, then the prize money, plus all the interest it has generated, will go to the Good Causes – adding to the £20 billion already raised through sales of lottery tickets since The National Lottery launched in November 1994.

A National Lottery spokesperson said: “We’re desperate to find this mystery ticket-holder and unite them with their winnings – this amazing prize could really make a difference to somebody’s life. We’re urging everyone to check their old tickets again or look anywhere a missing ticket could be hiding.

“Try checking in the pockets of clothing, in wallets, bags and down the back of the sofa – someone out there could literally be sitting on a fortune! We have the champagne on ice and our fingers crossed that the lucky winner comes forward to claim their win.”

To jog Lotto players’ memories on 21 July 2007, Rhianna was at the top of the singles chart with *Umbrella*, Enemy were top of the album charts with *We’ll Live and Die in these Towns* and the film *Hairspray*, starring John Travolta, had just been released at the cinema.

Anyone concerned about lost or unchecked tickets may like to consider either setting up a National Lottery Subscription, playing online at www.national-lottery.co.uk, on their mobile phone, or by using the Sky Active service on digital TV.
