£168,632 Prize Awaits Mystery Sussex Lotto Winner

An amazing Lotto prize of £168,632 has yet to be claimed in the Brighton, Hove and Worthing areas, and National Lottery players are being urged to check and double-check their tickets for the chance to claim this life-changing prize.

The search is now on to locate the owner of the winning ticket who matched five numbers plus the bonus ball in the Lotto draw on Saturday 9 December 2006. The winning Lotto numbers on that date were 5, 8, 10, 18, 20, 46 and the bonus ball was 43. The lucky ticket-holder has until 5.30pm on 7 June 2007 to come forward and make their claim.

If no-one comes forward with the winning ticket before the prize claim deadline, then the prize money, plus all the interest it has generated, will go to the Good Causes – adding to the £19 billion already raised through sales of lottery tickets since The National Lottery[®] launched in November 1994.

A National Lottery spokesperson said: “We’re desperate to find this mystery ticket-holder and unite them with their winnings – this life-changing prize could really help to make 2007 a year to remember. We’re urging everyone to check their old tickets again or look anywhere a missing Lotto ticket could be hiding.

“Try checking in the pockets of clothing, in wallets, bags and down the back of the sofa – someone out there could literally be sitting on a fortune! We have the champagne on ice and our fingers crossed that the lucky winner comes forward to claim their win.”

To jog Lotto players’ memories, on 9 December 2006 the animated film *Happy Feet*, was showing at cinemas across the country – while *Take That* topped the singles charts with *Patience*. Closer to home, audiences at Brighton’s Theatre Royal were enjoying a musical production of *Me and My Girl*.

Anyone who believes they have the winning ticket for any of the National Lottery draws within the 180-day deadline should call the **National Lottery Line** on **0845 910 0000**.

Anyone concerned about lost or unchecked tickets may like to consider setting up a National Lottery Subscription, playing Lotto Online, via their mobile phone, or using the Sky Active service on digital TV. Numbers can be entered in advance and lucky winners automatically receive a cheque or are notified online if their numbers come up.
