Domestic Assistant Cleans Up With Lotto Win

A hospital domestic assistant from Kirkcaldy is celebrating after mopping up a £347,471 share of last Saturday's (23 June 2007) Lotto jackpot.

Kathleen Leitchman (48), and her husband, Gordon (50) – who have three daughters and five grandchildren, ranging from three months to 10 years – are now polishing up their plans for the future, with bricks and mortar topping their list. Kathleen discovered her win when she was checking the numbers online on Sunday.

Kathleen commented: "I was checking the numbers on the computer and I couldn't believe the numbers matched mine, so I shouted to Gordon to come and take a look. When we realised we really had them all, I phoned my mother and she came over. We then had a party with family and friends on Sunday night. It's been non-stop since then!"

She added: "We're already buying a holiday apartment in Turkey and now we can buy it outright. As well as paying off our mortgage we're looking forward to lots more holidays and maybe a few treats for the grandchildren – but we will take advice and be sensible."

The winning Lucky Dip® ticket was bought at Sauchenbush Post Office in Pentland Place in Kirkcaldy. The winning Lotto numbers on Saturday 23 June were 06, 12, 19, 25, 31, 41, and the bonus ball was 21.

Tomorrow's (Wednesday 27 June) Lotto jackpot is an estimated £2.5 million, while this Friday's (29 June) EuroMillions jackpot is an estimated £17 million. Every Lotto play slip now comes with its own Dream Number – it is up to players to mark 'yes' to give their Dream Number its chance of winning up to £500,000, or choose a Lucky Dip.

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Notes to Editors:
