

## **£1.2 Million Lotto Jackpot Remains Unclaimed In Elmbridge Borough**

An amazing Lotto jackpot prize of **£1,293,634** has yet to be claimed in Elmbridge Borough, and National Lottery players are being urged to check and double-check their tickets for the chance to claim this life-changing amount of money.

The search is now on to find the owner of the winning ticket, bought in Elmbridge Borough, who matched all six numbers in the Lotto draw on Wednesday 25 April 2007. The winning numbers on that date were 1, 7, 25, 31, 32 and 39. The lucky ticket-holder has until 5.30pm on Monday 22 October 2007 to come forward and make their claim.

If no-one comes forward with the winning ticket before the prize claim deadline, then the prize money, plus all the interest it has generated, will go to the Good Causes – adding to the £20 billion already raised through sales of lottery tickets since The National Lottery® launched in November 1994.

A National Lottery spokesperson said: “We’re desperate to find this mystery ticket-holder and unite them with their winnings – this amazing prize could really make a difference to somebody’s life. We’re urging everyone to check their old tickets again or look anywhere a missing ticket could be hiding.

“Try checking in the pockets of clothing, in wallets, bags and down the back of the sofa – someone out there could literally be sitting on a fortune! We have the champagne on ice and our fingers crossed that the lucky winner comes forward to claim their win.”

To jog Lotto players’ memories, on 25 April 2007, *Reign Over Me*, starring Adam Sandler was showing at cinemas across the country – while Beyonce and Shakira were topping the charts with *Beautiful Liar*.
