Not A 'Lotto' Time To Go For Mystery Prizewinner **£86,945 lottery cash still up for grabs in the Highlands**

Time is running out for the missing owner of a Lotto ticket worth £86,945 bought in the Highlands area who only has until 5.30pm on Monday 14 May 2007 before the deadline to come forward to claim this life-enhancing prize expires.

The search is still on to find the mystery ticket-holder in time. They matched five numbers and the bonus ball in the Lotto draw on Wednesday 15 November 2006. The winning Lotto numbers on that date were 2, 3, 17, 22, 40, 42 and the bonus ball was 12.

If no-one comes forward with the winning ticket before the prize claim deadline, then the prize money, plus all the interest it has generated, will go to the Good Causes – adding to the £20 billion already raised through sales of lottery tickets since The National Lottery® launched in November 1994.

A National Lottery spokesperson said: "Time really is running out for the winner of this prize, but we are still hopeful that someone will come forward at the last minute to claim the money. We're urging everyone to check their old tickets again or look anywhere a missing Lotto ticket could be hiding. It could really help to make a few dreams become a reality for someone out there."

To jog Lotto players' memories, on 15 November 2006, *Breaking and Entering*, starring Jude Law and Juliette Binoche, was showing at cinemas across the country – while Akon and Eminem topped the charts with *Smack That*. Closer to home audiences at the Fortrose Community Theatre were enjoying a play about the poet *Emily Dickinson*, while Inverness CTFC fans were still contemplating their 2-0 defeat away to Hibernian in the Scottish Premier League.
