

Clock Is Ticking For Hounslow Mystery Prizewinner *£56,339.70 lottery cash still up for grabs in Hounslow*

Time is running out for the missing owner of a EuroMillions ticket worth £56,339.70 bought in the Hounslow area, who only has until 5.30pm on Wednesday 9 May 2007 before the deadline to come forward to claim this life-enhancing prize expires.

The search is now on to locate the owner of the winning ticket who matched the five main numbers in the EuroMillions draw on Friday 10 November 2006. The winning EuroMillions numbers on that date were 14, 21, 27, 30 and 36.

If no-one comes forward with the winning ticket before the prize claim deadline, then the prize money, plus all the interest it has generated, will go to the Good Causes – adding to the £20 billion already raised through sales of lottery tickets since The National Lottery® launched in November 1994.

A National Lottery spokesperson said: “Time really is running out for the winner of this prize, but we are still hopeful that someone will come forward at the last minute to claim the money. We’re urging everyone to check their old tickets again or look anywhere a missing lottery ticket could be hiding. It could really help to make a few dreams become a reality for someone out there.”

To jog Lotto players’ memories, on 10 November 2006 *Breaking and Entering*, starring Jude Law and Juliette Binoche, was showing at cinemas across the country – while Fedde Le Grand topped the charts with *Put Your Hands Up for Detroit*. Closer to home, audiences at the Globe were enjoying an evening of music from Texas Flood, while Hounslow Wanderers drew 2 – 2 with St John’s Athletic in the first division of the Middlesex County Football League.
