## **EuroMillions Prize Remains Unclaimed In Hackney**

An amazing EuroMillions prize of **£299,353.50** has yet to be claimed in the Borough of Hackney and National Lottery players are being urged to check and double-check their tickets for the chance to claim this life-enhancing prize.

The search is now on to find the owner of the winning ticket, bought in the Borough of Hackney, who matched the five main numbers plus one Lucky Star in the EuroMillions draw on Friday 19 October 2007. The winning EuroMillions numbers on that date were 7, 18, 34, 35 and 40 – and the Lucky Star numbers were 7 and 8. The lucky ticket-holder has until 5.30pm on Wednesday 16 April 2008 to come forward to make their claim.

If no-one comes forward with the winning ticket before the prize claim deadline, then the prize money, plus all the interest it has generated, will go to the Good Causes – adding to the £20 billion already raised through sales of lottery tickets since The National Lottery launched in November 1994.

A National Lottery spokesperson said: “We’re desperate to find this mystery ticket-holder and unite them with their winnings – this amazing prize could really make a difference to somebody’s life. We’re urging everyone to check their old tickets again or look anywhere a missing ticket could be hiding.

“Try checking in the pockets of clothing, in wallets, bags and down the back of the sofa – someone out there could literally be sitting on a fortune! We have the champagne on ice and our fingers crossed that the lucky winner comes forward to claim their win.”

To jog EuroMillions players’ memories, on Friday 19 October 2007, the latest Disney feature film, *Ratatouille*, was showing at cinemas across the country, and Sugababes topped the singles and albums charts with their single *About You Now* and album *Chance*.
