Lotto Prize Remains Unclaimed In Wolverhampton

An amazing Lotto prize worth **£59,212** has yet to be claimed in the Wolverhampton area, and National Lottery players are being urged to check and double-check their tickets for the chance to claim this life-enhancing prize and celebrate 2008 in style.

The search is now on to find the owner of the winning ticket, bought in the Wolverhampton area, who matched five numbers plus the bonus ball in the Lotto draw on Saturday 29 December 2007. The winning Lotto numbers on that date were 4, 13, 23, 28, 30 and 32 – the bonus ball was 11. The lucky ticket-holder has until 5.30pm on Thursday 26 June 2008 to come forward to make their claim.

If no-one comes forward with the winning ticket before the prize claim deadline, then the prize money, plus all the interest it has generated, will go to the Good Causes – adding to the £20 billion already raised through sales of lottery tickets since The National Lottery launched in November 1994.

A National Lottery spokesperson said: “This Lotto win would have been an ideal late Christmas present and we’re desperate to find this mystery ticket-holder and unite them with their winnings – this amazing prize could really make a difference to somebody’s life. We’re urging everyone to check their old tickets again or look anywhere a missing ticket could be hiding.

“Try checking in the pockets of clothing, in wallets, bags and down the back of the sofa – someone out there could literally be sitting on a fortune! We have the champagne on ice and our fingers crossed that the lucky winner comes forward to claim their win.”

To jog Lotto players’ memories, on Saturday 29 December 2007, *I Am Legend*, starring Will Smith, was showing at cinemas across the country. Leon Jackson secured the Christmas number one with *When You Believe*, while past X-Factor winner, Leona Lewis, kept the top spot in the album charts with *Spirit*.

Anyone concerned about lost or unchecked tickets may like to consider either setting up a National Lottery Subscription, playing online at www.national-lottery.co.uk, on their mobile phone, or by using the Sky Active service on digital TV.
