Only Days Left As Local Lotto Jackpot Win Remains Unclaimed

The clock is now ticking for a mystery local Lotto winner in the Great Yarmouth and Lowestoft areas who has one week left to claim an outstanding share of a Lotto jackpot worth **£548,030**.

The search is still on to find the owner of the winning ticket, who matched all six numbers in the Lotto draw on Boxing Day, Wednesday 26 December 2007. With just days to go, National Lottery players are being urged to check and double-check their tickets for the chance to claim this life-changing prize in time. The winning Lotto numbers on that date were 8, 14, 18, 23, 27 and 44. The lucky ticket-holder has until 5.30pm on Monday 23 June 2008 to come forward and make their claim.

If no-one comes forward with the winning ticket before the prize claim deadline, then the prize money, plus all the interest it has generated, will go to the Good Causes – adding to the £21 billion already raised through sales of lottery tickets since The National Lottery launched in November 1994.

A National Lottery spokesperson said: “Time really is running out for the winner of this prize, but we are still hopeful that someone will come forward at the last minute to claim the money and join the other Lotto winners across the UK. We’re urging everyone to check their old tickets again or look anywhere a missing Lotto ticket could be hiding. This life-changing prize could really help to make dreams become a reality for someone out there.”

With all National Lottery draws, players have 180 days from the day of the draw to claim their prize if they have the winning ticket. Anyone who believes they have the winning ticket for any of the National Lottery draws within the 180-day deadline should call the **National Lottery Line** on **0845 910 0000**.
