Lotto Prize Remains Unclaimed In Warrington *Two Lotto Tickets Yet To Be Claimed In The Town*

An amazing Lotto prize worth **£55,639** has yet to be claimed in the Warrington area and National Lottery players are being urged to check and double-check their tickets for the chance to claim this life-enhancing prize.

The search is now on to find the owner of the winning ticket, bought in the Warrington area, who matched five numbers plus the bonus ball in the Lotto draw on Saturday 9 February 2008. The winning Lotto numbers on that date were 2, 14, 26, 29, 31, 40 and the bonus ball was 7. The lucky ticket-holder has until 5.30pm on Thursday 7 August 2008 to come forward to make their claim.

If no-one comes forward with the winning ticket before the prize claim deadline, then the prize money, plus all the interest it has generated, will go to the Good Causes – adding to the £20 billion already raised through sales of lottery tickets since The National Lottery launched in November 1994.

This is not the only outstanding lottery prize in the Warrington area. A **£70,092** Lotto prize from the draw on Saturday 5 January 2008 has still not been claimed. The lucky winner who matched five numbers plus the bonus ball has until Thursday 3 July 2008 to come forward. The winning Lotto numbers on 5 January 2008 were 2, 3, 12, 20, 33, 49 and the bonus ball was 11.

A National Lottery spokesperson said: "We're desperate to find both mystery ticket-holders and unite them with their winnings – these amazing prizes could really make a difference to somebody's life. We're urging everyone to check their old tickets again or look anywhere a missing ticket could be hiding.

With all National Lottery draws, players have 180 days from the day of the draw to claim their prize if they have the winning ticket. Anyone who believes they have the winning ticket for any of the National Lottery draws within the 180-day deadline should call the **National Lottery Line** on **0845 910 0000**.

Anyone concerned about lost or unchecked tickets may like to consider either setting up a National Lottery Subscription, playing online at www.national-lottery.co.uk, on their mobile phone, or by using the Sky Active service on digital TV.
