

Lotto Prize Remains Unclaimed In Cardiff City

An amazing Lotto prize of **£78,507** has yet to be claimed in the Cardiff City area, so National Lottery players are being urged to check and double-check their tickets for the chance to claim this life-enhancing prize.

The search is now on to find the owner of the winning ticket, bought in the Cardiff City area, who matched five numbers and the bonus ball in the Lotto draw on Saturday 27 September 2008. The winning Lotto numbers on that date were 11, 21, 27, 38, 40, 44 and the bonus ball was 2. The lucky ticket-holder has until 5.30pm on Thursday 26 March 2009 to make their claim.

If no-one comes forward with the winning ticket before the prize claim deadline, then the prize money, plus all the interest it has generated, will go to the Good Causes – adding to the £21 billion already raised through sales of lottery tickets since The National Lottery launched in November 1994.

A National Lottery spokesperson said: “We’re desperate to find this mystery ticket-holder and unite them with their winnings – this amazing prize could really make a difference to somebody’s life. We’re urging everyone to check their old tickets again or look anywhere a missing ticket could be hiding.

“Try checking in the pockets of clothing, in wallets, bags and down the back of the sofa – someone out there could literally be sitting on a fortune! We have the champagne on ice and our fingers crossed that the lucky winner comes forward to claim their win.”

To jog Lotto players’ memories, on Saturday 27 September 2008, *Tropic Thunder* starring Ben Stiller, was showing at cinemas across the country, Kings of Leon topped the singles chart with *Sex on Fire*, while Metallica topped the album charts with *Death Magnetic*.
